Parent Tip: Read Us a Story

Children love listening to the same stories again and again — they never seem to tire of hearing their favourites!
Repetition helps them actively participate, anticipating what's coming next and joining in with enthusiasm. Use baby sign language with your children when reading stories to them; you'll find they often choose the story they want by signing the characters from a well-loved tale.
Reading isn't just fun — it's essential for literacy development and helps prepare children for school. Make time in your routine to read to your children
